## Conway swimmer wins Masters event over long course

Marvin Schwartz of Conway was one of three Arkansas swimmers to win championships in their age divisions at the 1990 National Masters Long Course Swimming Championships last week at Houston, Texas.

In the 40-44 division, Schwartz won the 800 freestyle in 9:54.12. He was fifth in the 200 freestyle (2:16.06) and 400 freestyle (4:47.94) and 11th in the 100 freestyle (1:03.53). He swam on a 200 freestyle relay team that finished ninth in 1:52.53.

Schwartz also swam on a 200 medley relay team with Frank Lorge, Rick Field and Doug Martin that broke the existing world record for their age division in finishing second in 1:59.71.

Field, formerly of Conway, finished third in the 50 breaststroke (36.17) and 100 breaststroke (1:20.97).

Norma Hoffrichter, 72, of Fayetteville won the 50 and 100 freestyle events and the 50 breaststroke in the 70-74 division and was second in the 50 backstroke. Frank Lorge won the 200 backstroke in the 40-44 division and was second in the 50 and 100 backstroke.

More than 900 swimmers participated.

Doug Martin and John Stein, all of Little Rock, broke the record for the 200-meter medley relay with a minute, 59.71-second time at the Masters Swimming National Long Course Championships in Houston. Marvin Schwartz of Little Rock won the 800-meter freestyle event. Norma Hoffrichter won three events in the 70-74 division.
