Foursome dominates Region 8 meet

David Weeks of Fayetteville, Keith Dixon of Little Rock, David Gillanders of Jonesboro and Max Heidenreich of Tulsa, Okla., dominated competition at the Region 8 Masters swim championships at the University of Arkansas' HPER Natatorium in Fayetteville April 4-5.

Weeks won five events — the 50-, 100- and 200-yard breaststrokes and the 200- and 400-yard individual medleys — while Dixon and Gillanders won three each.

Dixon took titles in the 100- and 200-yard backstrokes and the 200-yard freestyle. Gillanders, a former Olympic champion, won the 100-yard freestyle and the 100- and 200-yard butterflys.

Recreation notes

Heidenreich won the 100-yard individual medley, the 50-yard backstroke, the 50-yard butterfly and the 50-yard freestyle.

In the women's division, Louise Cleary of Oklahoma City set records in all seven events she entered — the 100-, and 500-yard freestyle, 100-, 200- and 400-yard individual medleys, and the 50- and 200-yard butterflys.

Ida Hlavacek of Mountain Home won the 200-yard breaststroke. Jo Anna Sharon

of Fayetteville took first in the 1,650-yard freestyle.

Region 8 includes Arkansas, Oklahoma, Texas, Louisiana and Missouri.
