

## Masters swimmers honored by club



Rick Field of Conway, David Gillanders of Jonesboro and Ida Hlavacek of Mountain Home were honored recently at the annual banquet of the Arkansas Masters Swim Club.

Field was presented the President's Award, one that doesn't necessarily go to a swimmer. Field has been active in the organization for several years, and since returning to competition as a masters swimmer, has eclipsed personal records he set as a collegian at the University of Delaware.

Gillanders, an electrical engineering instructor at Arkansas State University and a bronze medalist at the 1960 Olympics at Rome in the 200-meter butterfly, was named the outstanding male swimmer.

Hlavacek, one of the forces behind the organization of the state club and the holder of many age-group records in Arkansas, was named the outstanding female swimmer.

Also at the banquet, Chuck Letzig of Little Rock was announced as the president of the club, succeeding Doug Rawn.
